A Never-Forgotten Day

15th August is a special date for me - VJ Day - the date in 1945 when victory was declared over Japan, bringing to an end 4 years as a P.O.W. for my Dad. As it was the 75th anniversary this year, there was a special televised Remembrance Event at the National Memorial Arboretum, which I found very moving. I recalled visiting the Arboretum some years ago and there, in the section devoted to the Far East, being able to press a button and seeing his name engraved on the wall. Amongst his memorabilia I have a little booklet entitled 'A Church in a Troopship' which gives an account of God at work! This particular ship set sail from Scotland on 6th December, bound for Durban in South Africa. On board were two young men "crying out to God for souls to be saved and Christians strengthened and that, undeserving though they were, they might be fitted and used to this end." They started by advertising a Bible Study Circle which had a first attendance of just 6. It was intended that this would run weekly but this was soon changed, by demand, to nightly! Just one more excerpt from this booklet: "One special occasion must be mentioned. It was indeed a memorable event never to be forgotten. Christmas Eve is a special occasion and hark....in the warm evening air of a tropical port Christmas carols resound from a thousand voices. The aft part of the open deck was packed with a sea of faces and even the boat deck was thronged with officers. Q.M.S Jack L----'s (this is my Dad) Christmas message was the Gospel. Hallelujah! We preach Christ, and Him crucified. What an opportunity! We cannot tell the effect of that Christmas Eve service. We just know that it will live on in our memories for ever." I don't know what happened to the rest of the troops on board that boat but I do know that Dad was very soon captured and spent the rest of the war as a P.O.W. But this thing I do know, that his faith never wavered, and despite all the atrocities he suffered, it was stronger than ever. He eventually returned home on 18th December, 1945 and in September 1946 entered Cardiff Baptist College to train for the ministry. Oh, how he loved his Jesus!
